VOLUNTEER POSITIONS

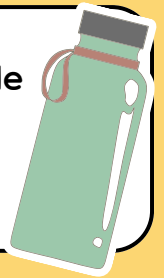
CABIN COUNSELORS

The primary caregivers for the campers, the Counselors are responsible for coordinating and carrying out activities and guiding campers in their personal growth. They will be directly responsible for managing 6-10 campers with their co-counselor and medical team.



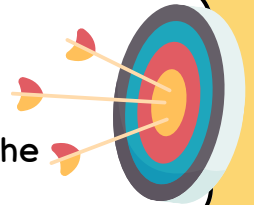
RECREATION STAFF

The essence of camp operations, the Recreation Staff are responsible for ensuring that the camp is well maintained and operating as efficiently as possible, which may include filling water jugs, setting up activities, and helping breakdown programs.



LIFEGUARDS & ARCHERY

The Lifeguards supervise aquatic areas to ensure camper safety, prevent accidents, and respond to emergencies. Archery Staff supervise and instruct campers on archery and ensure safety at the archery range. ****Camp will pay for certification courses****



MEDICAL STAFF

Critical in ensuring the health, safety, and well-being of campers and staff, the medical team manages the medical needs of campers, educates on diabetes management, and responds to health-related emergencies. ****Must have valid licensure in Maryland****
